APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- **Scholarship applicants must have a *minimum grade point average (GPA of 2.5)*. Electronic copy of official high school transcript must be emailed with application.**
- **Scholarship is available to a female student graduating high school from the Frankfort /Franklin County Area or participating in the Youth Leadership Academy who will be attending any College or University in the United States, Fall of 2023.**
- **A letter of recommendation must be received from a school official or an organization supporting community service (e.g. *Church Outreach, Red Cross, Big Brothers/Big Sisters, Salvation Army, Relay for Life, March of Dimes, etc.*)**
- **Applicants will be required to write and submit an original essay minimum of 250 words, describing applicant's aspirations, goals, financial needs and community service.**
- **Application, transcript & supporting documents must be received by April 30, 2023.**

Applicant(s) Selected as Scholarship Recipient:

- **Selected recipient(s) must present proof of college or university registration electronically prior to Frankfort Alumnae submitting payment directly to student.**
- **If the selected recipient fails to meet scholarship criteria, \$500.00 will be given to a candidate fulfilling above guidelines.**
- **Up to four scholarships will be awarded, totaling \$500 per scholarship.**
